

INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (IDOH) BUSINESS VACCINE PROVIDER ONBOARDING AND OVERVIEW

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) is actively working with business and industry partners to plan and operationalize internal closed vaccine clinics for employees, family, and friends (100 minimum). IDOH will provide businesses with vaccine and, if they wish, a system to schedule appointments and track required data. The businesses are expected to set up the clinic and provide staffing and resources. Key decisions necessary and initial steps to participate in the program are highlighted below.

Key Decisions

Step 1



Decide if you will use IDOH's system (Zotec) or your own system (EMR) to schedule and report information



Identify your interested employees – this can include friends and family members

Step 2



Work with your local partners to find staffing and vaccinators for your site



Determine vaccine clinic layout – it can be either a walk-up clinic or a drive through



Obtain necessary resources to run your vaccine clinic including cold storage

Next Steps
